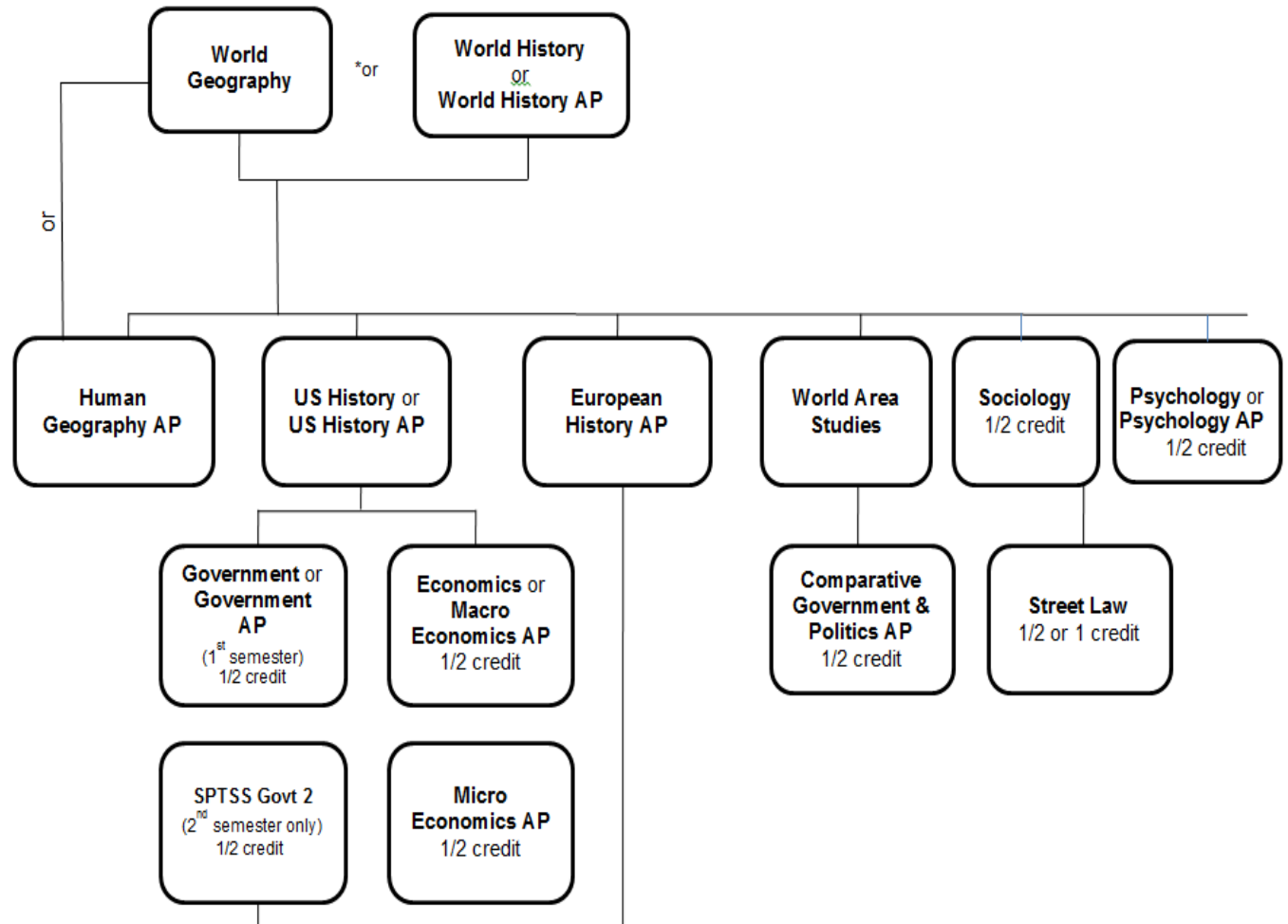

(4 levels of the same foreign language\*)

languages for a total of 4 credits\*)

**\*Note:** This includes the 2 credits of Foreign  
Language that are required for graduation

## OPTION 3:

### Fine Arts

(4 courses in the same fine arts area for 4 credits\*)

- Art (Visual Arts)  
(Drawing & Painting, Digital Art & Media, Ceramics/Sculpture, & Photography)
- Dance
- Music (Band)
- Music (Choir)
- Music (Orchestra)
- Theatre

**OR**

### Fine Arts Combo

(2 courses in each of 2 different fine arts areas for 4 total credits\*)

**\*Note:** This includes the 1 credit of Fine Arts that is required for graduation
