# Fine Arts

- 1 credit required
- May be taken in 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- Classes include:
  - Art
  - Music
  - Dance
  - Theatre



# Dance (Drill)

- Students interested in participating in the **Drill Team** in all four years of high school for an Arts and Humanities Endorsement, should include the following sequence in the 4 year plan:

**Dance I, II (Drill), III (Drill), IV (Drill) (9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>)**

\*This sequence will provide the student with the required graduation credits in **Fine Arts and P.E.** (P.E. credit earned after Dance II (Drill) has been completed)



# Dance

- Students who want to take Dance classes (**no** Drill Team) in all four years of high school for an Arts and Humanities Endorsement should include the following sequence in the 4 year plan:

**Dance I, II, III, IV – 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>**

\*This sequence will provide the student with the required graduation credit in **Fine Arts** after Dance I has been completed.

**Note:** P.E. credit is **not** earned with this course sequence and will have to be earned by taking a P.E. credit class.



# Art

- Art classes are selected based on a specific area of focus. Art I classes may be taken in any grade.

## Art I, II, III

- Drawing/Painting
- Sculpture/Ceramics
- Photography
- Digital Art & Media

## Art IV

- Studio 2D (Drawing/Painting)
- Studio 3D (Sculpture/Ceramics)
- Studio Photography
- Studio Digital Art & Media

\*This sequence will provide the student with the required graduation credit in **Fine Arts** after Art I has been completed.



# **Music- Band / Color Guard**

**Band I, II, III, IV**

**or**

**Band I-CG, II-CG, III-CG, IV-CG (Color Guard)**

\*Band I or Band-CG I will provide the student with the required graduation credits in **Fine Arts** and **P.E.** (P.E. credit earned after Band II or Band II-CG has been completed)



# Music - Choir

**Choir I, II, III, IV**

- **Boys or Girls**
- **Choir I can be taken in any grade  
9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>**

\*This sequence will provide the student with the required graduation credit in **Fine Arts** after Choir I has been completed.



# Music - Orchestra

## Orchestra I, II, III, IV

- Orchestra I can be taken in any grade  
9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>

\*This sequence will provide the student with the required graduation credit in **Fine Arts** after Orchestra I has been completed. Students new to the CFISD Orchestra program should have playing experience.





# Theatre

## Theatre Arts I, II, III, IV

- Acting / Performance

## Technical Theatre I, II, III, IV

- Set design/Lighting/Props/Costumes

## Theatre Production I, II, III, IV

- Production process as it relates to acting & technical theatre; **Teacher approval required**

\*This sequence will provide the student with the required graduation credit in **Fine Arts** after Course I has been completed.

# Physical Education

(or PE substitution)

- 1 credit required
- can be taken in 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- may earn a maximum of 4 credits in PE towards graduation

## Fine Art / Physical Education

This example shows a student that placed Art I Drawing and Painting in 10<sup>th</sup> grade and who wants to play football all four years of high school. This student will have to place their Endorsement classes and any other electives in 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade since 9<sup>th</sup> grade is fully scheduled.

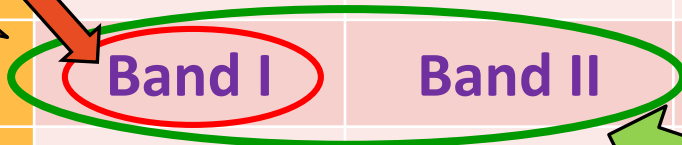
# Fine Art / Physical Education

This example shows a student that has chosen Band as their Fine Art credit. By also taking Band II, this student will earn the required PE credit for graduation and will not have to take a separate PE class.

## Fine Art / Physical Education
